

SWIMMING POOL RULES

GUESTS ARE REQUIRED TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES



- Access to the pool is allowed during the following hours: **09:00 to 19:30**
- Minors and disabled individuals must be accompanied to enter the pool
- Children up to 12 years old are allowed in the pool only if they wear a life jacket
- Children under the age of three must wear appropriate swim diapers
- The depth of the pool is 1.40 meters throughout
- It is mandatory to take a shower before entering the water
- Diving and running on the pool deck are prohibited, and it is recommended not to swim within three hours of consuming a meal
- Free diving activities are not allowed without the presence of a certified instructor
- Animals are not allowed in the pool area
- The use of sunscreens and hair oils before entering the pool is prohibited
- Bottles, glass objects, and other items not strictly related to bathing are not allowed in the pool
- Bathing is not allowed during specific weather conditions (thunderstorms)
- People in altered psycho-physical conditions (intoxication, drug effects, etc.) or obvious precarious health conditions that may endanger their safety are not allowed to enter the pool
- Leaving waste in the garden area is prohibited
- The management is not liable for any incidents, injuries, or other events that may occur to swimmers due to their own behavior, especially if in violation of this regulation
- According to the law, showering and bathing without swimwear are prohibited



The lifeguard at the pool is required by law to take action against those who do not comply with the rules. We kindly ask for your cooperation.
